ORDINANCE NO. 1783-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELSMERE, KENTUCKY AMENDING TITLE VII:
TRAFFIC CODE CHAPTER 73 "BICYCLES AND SKATEBOARDS" OF THE
ELSMERE, KENTUCKY CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, Chapter 73 "BICYCLES AND SKATEBOARDS" sets forth requirements for bicycles and skateboards in the City of Elsmere, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elsmere, Kentucky has determined that the current Ordinance needs to be amended;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ELSMERE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

That Chapter 73 Bicycles and Skateboards" of the Elsmere, Kentucky Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

SECTION I

73.01 OBEDIENCE TO TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES: YIELDING RIGHT OF WAY

Any person using or operating a bicycle upon the public streets or thoroughfares of the city shall obey the instructions of official traffic control signals, signs, and other control devices applicable to vehicles, unless otherwise directed by a police officer [~~come to a complete stop at all stop signs and shall obey the directions of all traffic lights within the city~~] and shall yield the right-of-way to all motor vehicles properly using the public streets and thoroughfares. ('76 Code, § 60.16(A)) Penalty, see § 73.99

SECTION TWO

This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force after its enactment and publication as required by law.

SECTION THREE

All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of the conflict, if any, are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION FIVE

Publication of this Ordinance is hereby authorized to be by summary publication in accordance with Kentucky Law.
